

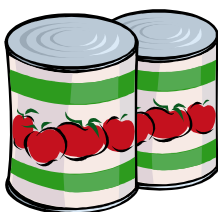
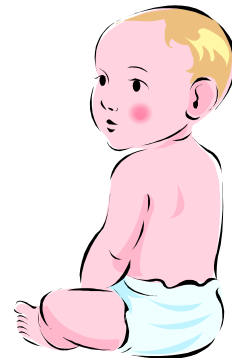
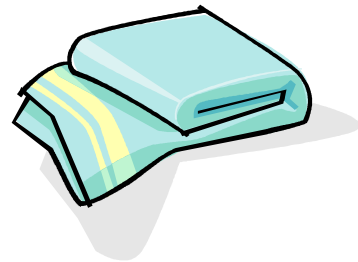
Always Needed - Wish List

Liberation Programs, Inc. provides two residential treatment programs – one for mothers and their children as well as pregnant women and one for single men. There are usually 75 to 85 men, women and children in these programs at any given time. Unfortunately, some of our clients come to us with not even a single change of clothes. Due to health regulations many items can only be accepted if they are new. At this time, we are **not able to accept** used clothing, used toys, used small or large appliances or furniture.

The following items, however, are always needed and always welcome.

- New pillows and pillow cases
- New single bed sheets
- New blankets
- New bath towels and wash cloths
- New flip-flops – Men’s XL and Women’s L

- Men’s and women’s new socks
- New - large and x-Large sweat pants – T-shirts
- Diapers – all sizes
- Baby wipes – baby products such as lotion, shampoo, etc.
- New children’s clothes
- Adult shampoo and conditioner
- Deodorant and soap
- Toothbrushes and toothpaste – denture products
- Disposable razors – shaving cream
- New hair brushes
- Cleaning supplies
- Paper towels and other paper products
- Canned goods
- Passenger van to carry clients to appointments
